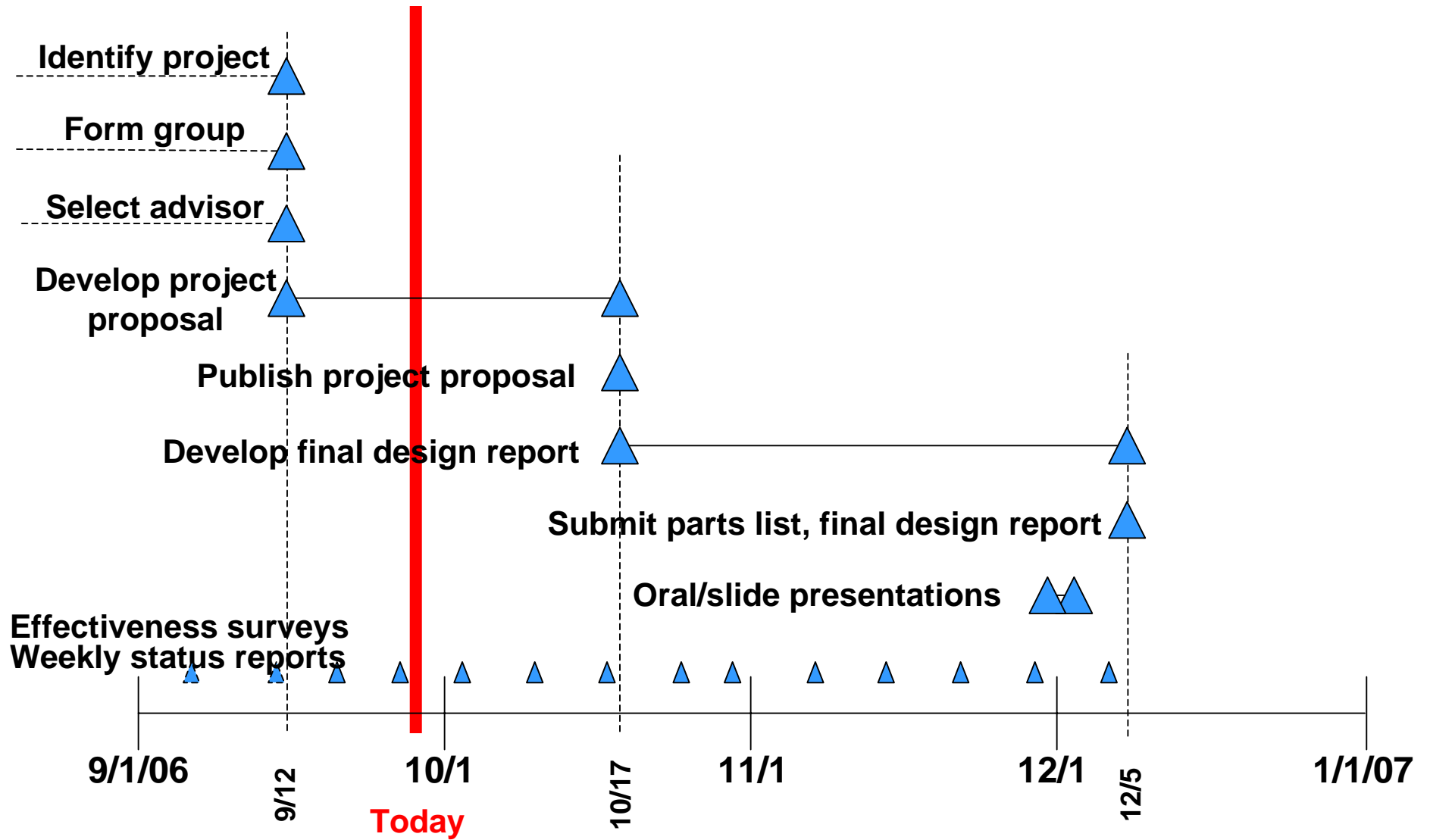

Weekly Reports and Effectiveness Reports

- Every member of every group needs to submit an effectiveness report each week
- Every group needs to submit a weekly report each week, rotating authorship thru group
- Report submission needs to include information in header, title to identify group number, due date and type of report
- All reports need to be emailed separately
- Reports need to be sent to proper distribution (e.g., me, Mary Schurgot, Maggie Hames) for credit
- Weekly reports need to reflect effort expended for current week – each student should be expending 6-8 hours per week on Senior Design (a 4 person group should be reporting about 24-32 hours per week)

 - Current grades would be 7@100, 2@83, 1@38, 1@0 from MY count
- Every group needs to submit a weekly report each week, rotating authorship thru group
 - One group has missed a report, one group is not rotating author (again, MY count)
- Report submission needs to include information in header, title to identify group number, due date and type of report
 - Only about 2/3rds of the groups are doing this consistently
- All reports need to be emailed separately
 - about 10% of the reports are not
- Reports need to be sent to proper distribution (e.g., me, Mary Schurgot, Maggie Hames) for credit
 - Reports that don't get sent to the proper distribution will not be credited (~15%)
- Weekly reports need to reflect effort expended for current week – each student should be expending 6-8 hours per week on Senior Design (a 4 person group should be reporting about 24-32 hours per week)
 - One group reported 2 hours total for the week – Senioritis isn't supposed to appear until the Spring!
